## **Pre-arrival**

- Location For full contact details and maps of how to reach us, please see the 'Find us' information on <u>www.kent.gov.uk/pegwellbay</u>
- Arriving by car the picnic site is signposted from the Sandwich Road (A256). There are two car parking areas (see Arrival below). If you are a Blue Badge holder, you can obtain an annual season ticket in advance of your visit, which gives you access to all the Kent Country Parks car parks free of charge during the year. There is a £3 admin fee for this service. To obtain your season ticket, please call 03000 41 72 72 and have your Blue Badge number and credit/debit card handy for reference
- Arriving by public transport the nearest train station is Ramsgate which is 3 miles away. Local taxi company United cars number is 01843 581 58. Bus route number 9 from Canterbury City Centre, call stagecoach for more details 0871 200 22 33.

## Arrival

- The car parking area at Pegwell Bay comprises a small car park to the left as you enter the park and another straight ahead, facing the sea. Neither car parking area has allocated bays. However, the areas are hard standing and flat. The car park to the left of entry is next to the WC facilities.
- Car parking machines are at a height suitable for wheelchair use and require users to enter their car registration numbers. A fee of £1.50 in the week, and £2.00 at weekends is required. No change is given.

# **Visitor Facilities**

There is one separate unisex disabled toilet which is accessible during park opening times with a radar key via a ramp which is fully DDA compliant

There is a mobile catering facility most days and this is situated within the car parking area.

### **Park Facilities**

• Play area

The play area is situated close to the main car parking area and can be accessed via a gate which is 1.1m wide. To reach it, access can be made via a non-made up path through some trees or across the main picnic area (to the right of the main entrance) or alternatively across a grassy area which is circled by a grassy mound approximately 0.8m

### **Our Paths**

The main coast path from the car park is surfaced and flat, this links up with a Sustrans route (cycle path) meaning it is possible for a circular route to be undertaken. There are also a number of internal closely mowed permissive paths networking through the centre of the site in between grazing compartments and rough grass areas.
