ADMISSION TO THE SCHOOL SEPTEMBER 2016

The planned admission number is 30. Applicants are advised to consult "Admission to Primary School 2016" guidance which is available from the Kent County Council.

This policy has been compiled by the Governing Body, in consultation with the Local Authority and the Diocese of Rochester. If more parents express a preference for our school than the published number of places, the Governors will use the following criteria in order of priority to award places after the closing date of admissions (or during the year of admission if other than Reception age).

Where it is necessary to establish priority within one of the criteria the distance from home to school as calculated by the Local Authority will be used. The distance is measured in a straight line from a point in the child's permanent address to a point in the school using Ordnance Survey address point data. In the event of a tie-breaker the nearness of an applicant's home to the school will be the decider.

Children in Local Authority Care – a child under the age of 18 years for whom the local authority provides accommodation by agreement with their parents/carers (Section 22 of the Children Act 1989) or who is the subject of a care order under Part IV of the Act. This applies equally to children who immediately after being looked after by the local authority became subject to an adoption, residence or special guardianship order. (As defined by Section 46 of the Adoption and Children Act 2002 or Section 8 or 14A of the Children Act 1989)

- Note 5 Signed letter from relevant clergy confirming the stated attendance at other churches
- Note 6 The Governors operate the Diocese of Rochester's approved procedure for any appeal against refusal admission to the school
- Note 7 If necessary, the Governors will operate a waiting list system in which children will be prioritised in line with the oversubscription criteria above until the end of the relevant academic year
- Note 8 Where applications are received for children who are from multiple births, places will be offered individually to each child, prioritised by alphabetical order according to the forename on the birth certificate
