\* Stagecoach enforces certain restrictions in order to manage capacity within their network of services, such as on services 4X and 6X (Herne Bay to Canterbury) and at certain times on services 23 (Canterbury to Spring Lane Estate), 34 (Ramsgate to Marlowe Academy), 60 (River to Dover), 102 (Lydd to Dover) and 160 (Hythe to Folkestone). Alternative services are available - please contact Stagecoach for details (08456 00 22 99).

Although London Buses (TfL) do not accept the Kent Freedom Pass for travel, 11 – 15 year olds can apply for an Oystercard, which gives free travel on their services, within Kent and across the whole of Greater London.
