Campaign updates

Anti-bullying: Attended by 11 members

- Group completed a campaign update for the June newsletter
- Wrote lyrics for a You Tube video competition
- Decided on content for 5 x 1min videos for You Tube

Curriculum for life: attended by 17 members

- Group completed a campaign update for the June newsletter
- Political campaign sub group discussed political party topic overview, how to deliver booklet and where to send
