Process for restocking of warden supplies:

When you warden requires replacement supplies of any of the items listed above in your warden kit, please email your request to us at <u>CAS.Volunteer@kent.gov.uk</u>.

We can then arrange to either post out smaller items or arrange a collection venue, date, and time at either the Public Rights of Way central, East Kent, or West Kent offices.

Please take enough supplies to keep you going for 3-6 months, it is very helpful to us if you pick up your own supplies as it saves us time and postage costs to send them to you directly.

You can reclaim travel costs within these limits:

- Up to 4 resupply travel claims per year
- A maximum round trip of 20 miles [at 40p per mile]
- A maximum of £8 public transport fares Claim forms are available on request.
