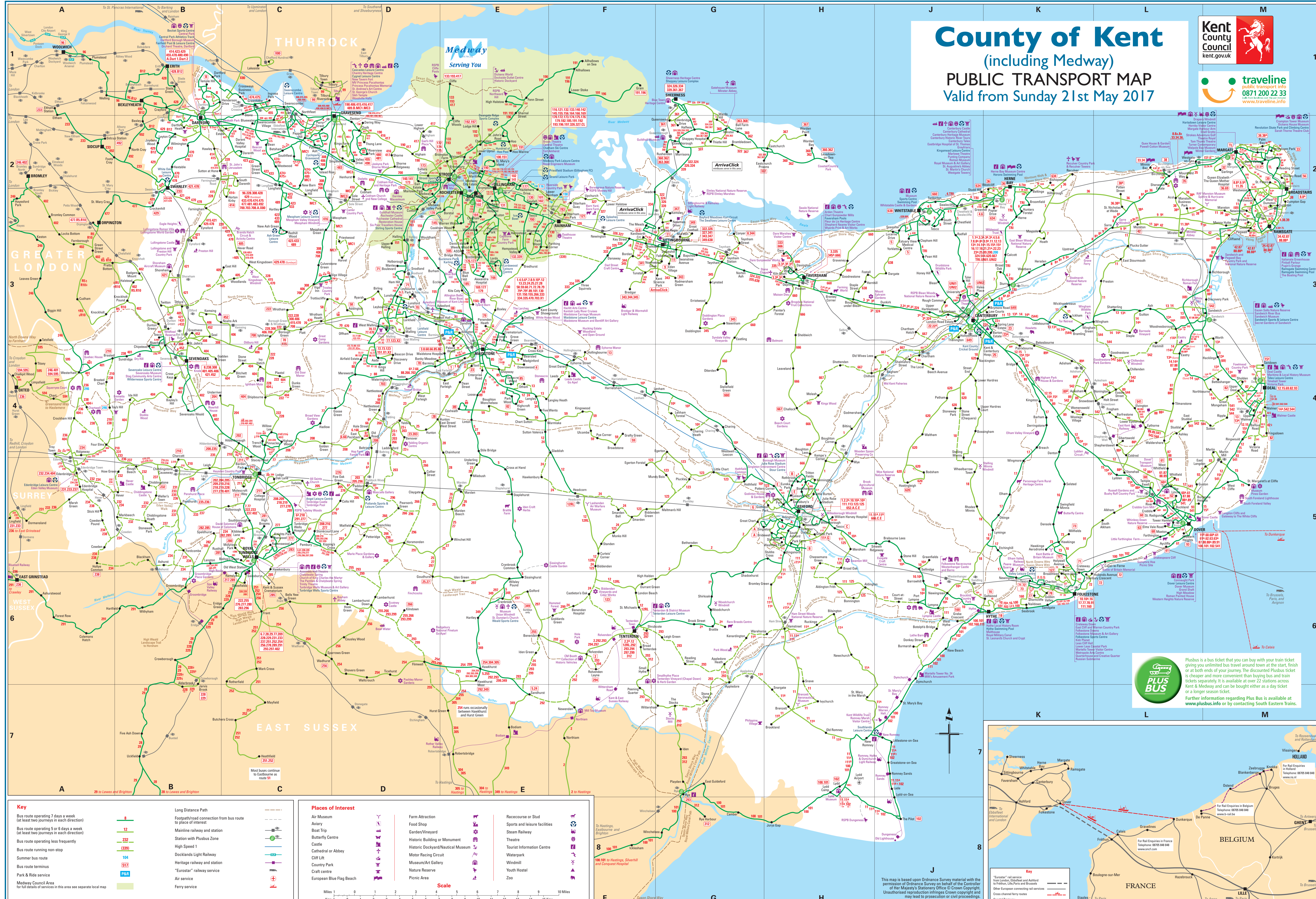


INDEX TO PLACES SERVED
