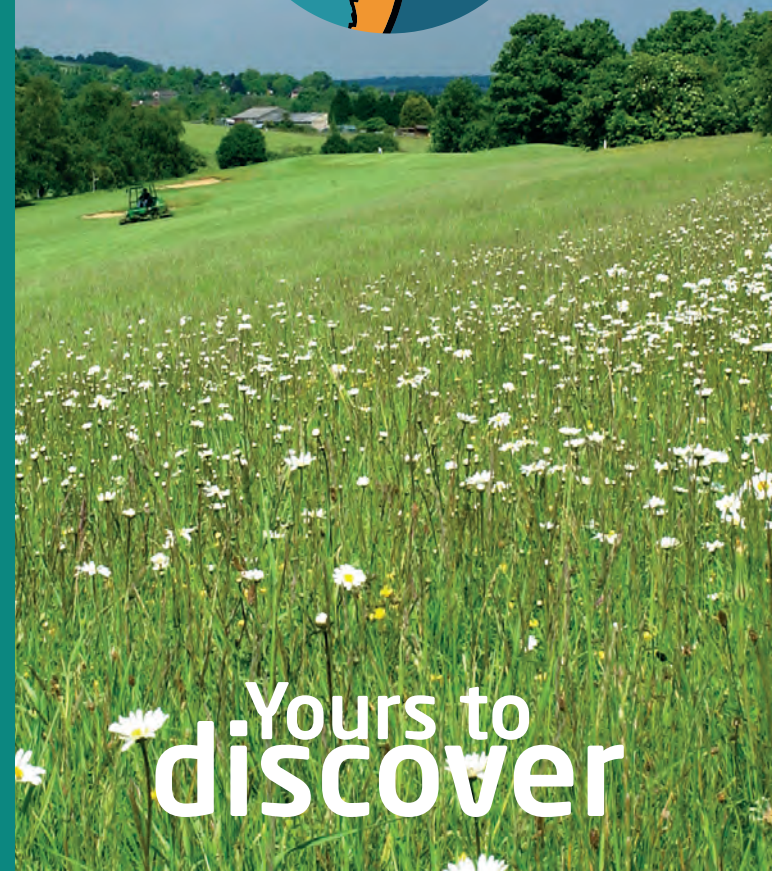
By car – signposted on the A225 towards Otford, after the entrance to Lullingstone Castle.

Woodland Walk - A 3.2km circular route taking in breathtaking views of the Darent Valley. The route includes semi-ancient woodland habitats with a variety of trees, flowers and fungi.

Lullingstone Loop - This challenging 6.4km circular route passes Lullingstone Roman Villa and Lullingstone Castle as you take in magnificent views of the Darent Valley.

Discovery Trail - An easy 2.4km route designed for children, this route includes play equipment along the way. It also leads to a bird hide where you can sit and view some of the park's array of birdlife.

Horse Route - A 6.3km circular route. Riders are welcome at the park. Please phone 03000 411811 to arrange horse box parking.

Dog walkers: Please keep dogs under close control and avoid allowing your dog on the fairways and bunkers at all times.
