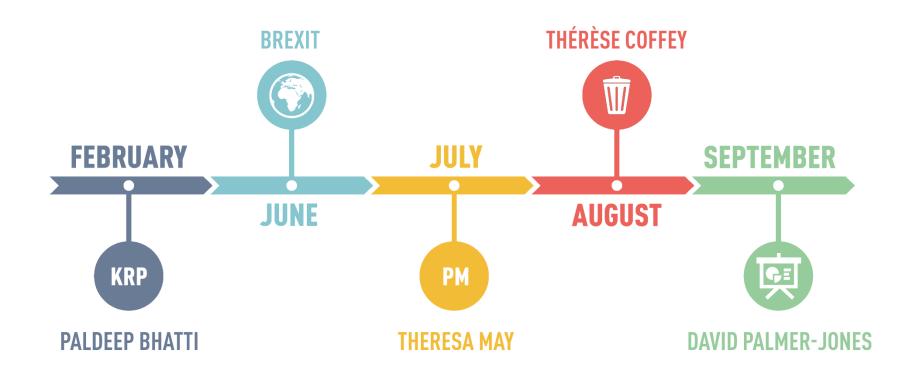

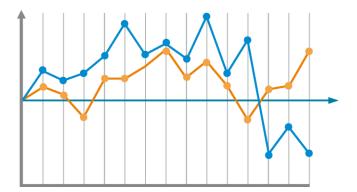
### A lot can happen in a year!





### **Implications of Brexit?**

- Early days yet, but some economic impact on Sterling £
  - Increasing cost of RDF
  - Slight improvement in commodity prices



- Loss of EU direction on legislation / circular economy package
- Brexit negotiation = policy vacuum
- New department DECC+BIS = BEIS (Industrial Strategy)





#### **Need for action!**

- Commodity values and end of PFI's prevent further investment
- New infrastructure build not keeping up with landfill closures
- Significant treatment gap created with still 17M tonnes landfilled
- Saturation of RDF 'safety valve'

- Send strong signals now –
   vision, consistency and stability
- Recognise the opportunity of Resource Industry
- Support the development of infrastructure

 Develop progressive policy to shift behaviour and funding
