Through this charter, Kent County Council pledges to work with partners in all sectors to do the following:

- Promote a range of volunteering opportunities which enable everyone in Kent to make a contribution through volunteering
- Strategically develop and support volunteering projects that are managed where appropriate within the voluntary sector
- Organise an Annual Volunteering Fair to promote volunteering opportunities
- Ensure training and development pathways are available and communicated to volunteers
- Encourage organisations deploying volunteers to be accredited as Investing in Volunteers
- Raise awareness, knowledge and adoption of the Kent Compact's Code of Practice on Volunteering which establishes and promotes best practice
- Encourage ongoing employee volunteering to businesses countywide, as good practice in staff development and corporate social responsibility
- Establish a mechanism to encourage philanthropic giving into volunteering initiatives and projects
- Recognise and acknowledge volunteers for the important impact they have on the Kent community
