## **Multi-agency safeguarding adults training:**

### **Workshop on exploitation – including cuckooing, modern slavery, mate crime and county lines**

#### **Half-day workshop**

The training has been agreed and is commissioned by the Kent and Medway Safeguarding Adults Board, and is developed as part of an integrated programme of development for staff from statutory partner agencies. Each agency provides its own introductory safeguarding adults training, as well as other associated learning. Contact your agency's lead for learning and development to discuss available training relevant for your role.

This course is primarily for those staff with responsibility for direct practice in safeguarding. As safeguarding is integral to all work, it is important that delegates who attend the course have the agreement and support of their line manager and that adequate cover for attendee's absence has been arranged.

#### **Coronavirus COVID-19 update**

Whilst face to face training is not possible, facilitated online training sessions have been designed, enabling delegates to participate through a video conferencing platform, which will ensure training is interactive, practical and relevant to practice.

The Domestic Abuse workshop will be delivered across two half-day remote training sessions of 3 hours each, with built-in breaks. Where these take place on different dates, delegates must be able to attend both dates with the same group.

Course workbooks will be e-mailed in advance, along with detailed instructions for participants, including any preparation which may be required.

## Who this course is for

Those with some experience and knowledge of safeguarding and who have completed their agency basic training. Delegates wishing to book a place should ensure the training is appropriate for their role and ideally the training need will have been identified in discussions with their manager.

## Learning objectives

1. Participants will gain an understanding of Modern Slavery, Cuckooing, Mate Crime, County Lines and Gangs
2. Attendees will have the opportunity to look at the local Kent and Medway perspective and learn about the local picture relating to exploitation and local referral reporting mechanisms
3. The course will centre around collaborative working, family focus, information sharing, professional curiosity and prevention
4. Delegates will explore contextual safeguarding and multiple exploitation risks from organised crime

The course will include the use of Protocols for Kent and Medway to Safeguarding Adults who are at Risk of Sexual Exploitation, Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking, as well as current research and best practice to ensure interventions are effective. Learning from Safeguarding Adults Reviews (SARs) will be utilised, and case examples examined to adopt a strength based collaborative working approach.

The course will also look at when and how to escalate a case and National Reporting Mechanisms.
