Progress so far and some of the next steps...

Barrack Row

South Side

- The new bus stops are now in use.
- Construction of the Copenhagen Crossing is now complete (**see Figure 1**).
- The bus stops in Clive Road have now reopened after a temporary closure.
- Progress is being made on the granite paving.
- Some street furniture will soon be installed.
- The lighting to the canopies will soon be installed.
- The palisade fence is complete.

North Side

- Working in smaller areas laying granite paving to maintain pedestrian access to businesses (**see Figures 2, 3 and 4**).
- Further kerbing to be installed during February.

Garrick Street

- All the bus stops and paving have been removed.
- Street furniture has been retained by Gravesham for future use.
- Extensive groundworks have been undertaken with the installation of new ducting and the upgrade of drainage (**see Figure 5**).

Darnley Road

- Some groundworks have been temporarily closed until BT are able to return to site.
- Nightworks went ahead in mid-January to complete ducting work for water and telecom connections.

Advance Warning: Night Resurfacing Works

As part of our work on the new Gravesham Bus Hub, we will be carrying out night resurfacing works in Gravesend Town Centre from Wednesday 16th February 2022 for up to 4 nights.

- To facilitate this, the following traffic management will be in place.
- No access onto New Road from the Darnley Road/Bath Street junction.
- Garrick Street and Barrack Row will also be closed, with no access for buses and cycles from Clive Road via the bus gate onto Barrack Row.
- There will be lane closures in place on Darnley Road between the junction with Rathmore Road and Barrack Row.

All road closures and traffic management will be in place from **07:00pm – 05:00am** the following morning on all given dates. Please note these dates/timings could be subject to changes due to performance and weather.
