Ref: Armstrong Road / Park Way / A229 Loose Road, Maidstone - Highway Improvement scheme

As part of the wider 'Keep Maidstone Moving' package of works, Kent County Council aims to reduce congestion and ease traffic movements at locations within Maidstone.

The Armstrong Road / Park Way scheme remains consistent with that previously consulted on from 29 January 2020 to 11 March 2020 and will be the first of the A229 Loose Corridor schemes to be delivered.

The works will involve carrying out widening at Park Way, introducing an additional right turn lane on the A229 southbound approach, an additional left turn lane on the Park Way approach and the existing staggered pedestrian crossing will be relocated to the Northbound approach of the A229 Loose Road.

As a result of these works we will be closing Park Way, from its junction with the A229 to its junction with Holtye Crescent for a minimum duration of 8 weeks. Access will be restricted to residents only during that time.

In addition, the closure of Armstrong Road directly at the junction with the A229 Loose Road will be required for short periods during the same minimum 8-week period.

The works are due to start in early October and the closures are currently scheduled to begin week commencing Monday 3rd October 2022.
