

# Moving to Kent with an education, health and care (EHC) plan



The below outlines the standard process that should happen; however, outcomes and education settings will be different for each child or young person going through this process.


## STEP 1



### NOTIFY

You should notify your previous local authority within 15 days before the move to Kent

## STEP 2



### TRANSFER

Within 15 days of being notified, your previous local authority will transfer your child or young person's EHC plan to us.


## STEP 3



### CHECKS TAKE PLACE

Your current choice of education setting will be reviewed to see if it works for your child or young person. If it is not, we will make alternative arrangements.

## STEP 4



### CONFIRMATION

We will then contact you after receiving your child or young person's EHC plan. We will confirm when we will review the plan and if we will carry out a new EHC needs assessment.

## STEP 5




### REVIEW THE EHC PLAN

Within 3 months, we will review your child or young person's EHC plan either:

- from the date of transfer
- within 12 months of the original EHC plan being made or last reviewed (whichever is later).

## STEP 6



### ANNUAL REVIEWS

Your child or young person's annual review will take place. Your child or young person's needs and education setting are then reviewed.
