## MAKE SURE IT'S THE RIGHT DEAL FOR YOU



#### **BE REALISTIC**

You are buying a used car - don't expect perfection! Think about what journeys you will make. Know what you can afford and stick to it. Don't forget costs like insurance, servicing, parts and fuel.

### **DO YOUR RESEARCH**

Once you know the type of car you are looking for, do some research. Shop around, look for customer reviews of your dealership online, ask friends and family.

## **ASK QUESTIONS**

Ask the dealer about...

- The condition of the car
- Repairs carried out on the car
- What happens if things go wrong
- MOT certificates
- Service history
- V5C registration document (logbook)

## **BE SURE**

- Check the car for rust, electrics, dents etc.
- Take someone with you
- Ask for copies of paperwork
- Take it for a test drive
- Consider paying for an inspection



### I'VE HAD A PROBLEM WITH MY SECOND HAND CAR, WHAT SHOULD I DO?

#### YOU SHOULD...

- Tell the dealer as soon as you can
- Allow the dealer to look at the car
- Ask the dealer to contact you when they have found a fault
- Tell the dealer if you are unhappy with their service

#### YOU SHOULD NOT...

- Ignore the problem
- Expect a courtesy car
- Take the car to another business before the dealer has looked at the car
- Stop paying finance
