

Urban/rural areas in Kent & Medway

This bulletin presents the 2021 Rural Urban Classification from the Office for National Statistics released in March 2025.

NOTE: The term “Kent” refers to the Kent County Council area which excludes Medway

The 2021 classification of rural and urban areas (2021 RUC) provides a standardised method for categorising geographies as either rural or urban. This bulletin presents the 2021 RUC for areas within Kent and Medway.

- 73.9% of the population of Kent live in urban areas while 26.1% live in rural areas.
- Sevenoaks has the highest proportion of population living in rural areas (46.4%).
- Thanet has the highest proportion of population living in urban areas (97.8%).
- When aggregated to ward level, all Thanet wards are categorised as urban as they have a higher proportion of population in areas that are classed as urban.
- More than half the wards in Sevenoaks (57.7%) are classed as rural.

Introduction

The 2021 classification of rural and urban areas (2021 RUC) was released by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) in March 2025. It provides a standardised method for categorising geographies as either rural or urban, based on:

- Address density
- Physical settlement form
- Population size
- Relative access to major towns and cities (populations of over 75,000 people)

The 2021 RUC is published by ONS for Output Area (OA), Lower Layer Super Output Area (LSOA), Middle Layer Super Output Area (MSOA) and Local Authority Districts (LAD) geographies. It is produced by the ONS, with advice from the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra), the Welsh Government (WG) and the Government Geography Profession (GGP).

The following table shows how geography types are grouped into urban and rural areas.

The 2021 RUC is released to Output Areas (OAs). These are the lowest level of geographical area for census statistics and were first created following the 2001 Census. They typically have between 40 and 250 households, and usual resident population between 100 and 625 persons.

ONS did not release data at ward level. The data uses OAs as their base which can be used to build to larger geographies such as wards.


By using OA data we can assign rural and urban classifications to wards. ONS guidance recommends to use the category that has the most population in it as the category for the ward. For example when grouping OAs to ward, if a ward has 30% population in 'urban', 25% in 'larger rural' and 45% in 'smaller rural', then its overall settlement class would be smaller rural.

Analysis

In Kent, 73.9% of the resident population live in areas which are classified as urban areas, while 26.1% of the population lives in rural areas.

All Kent districts have a higher proportion of population living in urban areas. Thanet has the highest proportion in urban areas (97.8%) while Sevenoaks has the lowest proportion (53.6%).




