Notice of Adoption of a Supplementary Development Plan Document (SPD)

Safeguarding Supplementary Planning Document

In accordance with paragraphs 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the Kent Country Council adopted the Safeguarding Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on the **18** March 2021.

The SPD aims to provide guidance and assistance for local authorities, applicants and the public in understanding how the Council will implement planning policies in relation to safeguarded land-won minerals, and safeguarded mineral and waste management infrastructure. It forms part of the Kent Minerals and Waste Local Plan 2013-30 (as modified by Partial Review). In doing so it outlines the process by which applicants can expect planning applications to be assessed in relation to the minerals and waste safeguarding issues if relevant and for local planning authorities on how allocations in local plans may have to assess such matters as local plans are formulated.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the SPD, may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision, and that any such application must be made promptly and, in any event, not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
