Progress so far



Barrack Row

South Side The majority of the kerb line on this side of Barrack Row has been completed, but material delivery issues are still having an impact on the completion date for this phase of the project.

The granite paving including grouting is making good progress (1). The east bus canopy has been installed (2) and the toilet block is in place (3).



Darnley Road FMC have completed ducting work for a new BT connection, including carriageway reinstatement (4).

Station Car Park Tying in detail between the L-wall and old concrete wall completed using gabion baskets (5 and 6). Kerbs installed and the first stages of asphalt reinstatement. (7)

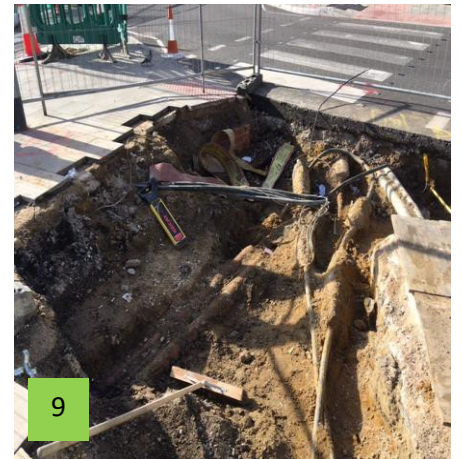

Bus Stop Changes, Upcoming Road Closures and Buses on Diversion.

By late November our work at the junction of Clive Road with Barrack Row, will require that junction to be closed. The bus stops in Clive Road will be out of use with diversions in place.

In the early weeks of 2022 Garrick Street and Barrack Row will be closed overnight, whilst resurfacing takes place. Buses will be on diversion.

Please keep a look out for the relocation of bus stops in Garrick Street, which will take place during late November. Information will be posted on the stops to let you know where the new stops have been relocated to. It will be within a short walking distance.
