Barrack Row - South Side

- Planting has been installed in the flush planter in front of the fence. (1)
- Lighting works to canopies has taken place. (2)
- Some street furniture has been installed. (3)

North Side

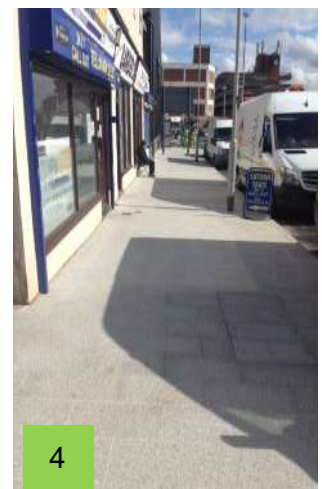
- Granite paving has been completed from the junction with Garrick Street to Darnley Road. (4)
- Paving has been completed outside The Somerset Arms. (5)

Garrick Street - West Side

- The bus canopies adjacent to Tesco have been installed. (6)

- The granite paving works at this location are ongoing with the walkway cordoned off for pedestrians. (7)

Completion of the traffic island, footway works and installation of new traffic signals in Darnley Road.

New street lighting and final street furniture installations, throughout the scheme.

Completion of the bus canopies in Garrick Street.

Advance Warning – Night Works in Gravesend Town Centre.

As part of the work on the new Gravesham Bus Hub, F M Conway will be carrying out night works in Gravesend Town Centre from **Monday 4th April over a maximum period of 4 nights**. The works will be ongoing at several locations with road closures and width restrictions in place.

All road closures and traffic management will be in place from **07:00pm – 05:00am** the following morning on all given dates.
