

ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION – WHITE HORSE WOOD

Pre-arrival

- **Arriving by car** – the park is signposted from the A249. There is a main car parking area at the end of the long entrance drive. If you are a Blue Badge holder, you can obtain an annual season ticket in advance of your visit, which gives you access to all the Kent Country Parks car parks free of charge during the year. There is a £3 admin fee for this service. To obtain your season ticket, please call 03000 41 72 72 and have your Blue Badge number and credit/debit card handy for reference.
- **Arriving by public transport** – the nearest Train station is Bearsted which is 1.5 miles away up Thurnham lane, local Taxis company is Apollo Taxis 01622 670006. The park is not serviced by other public transport links.

Arrival

- The car park is situated from the main driveway. It is flat and hard standing.
- Car parking machines are at a height suitable for wheelchair use and require users to enter their car registration numbers. A fee of £1.50 in the week, and £2.00 at weekends is required. No change is given.

Visitor Facilities

- There are no visitor facilities at this park
- Thurnham Castle is a separate part of the Country Park and is accessible by foot from the main country park and car park by way markers.

Park Facilities

The main path at the park is flat and wide. There are a number of kissing gates that link one side of the park to the other they are not navigable in a wheelchair.
