## Progress so far



### Barrack Row

We have made great headway since our last update:

- The vacant buildings in Barrack Row have now been demolished.
- New ducting has been installed for traffic signals, water supply and BT connections
- We have undertaken excavation works to mark out a new kerb line on the southern side of Barrack Row
- We have removed the concrete plinth at the top of the car park embankment

## How our team working on the Gravesham Bus Hub is contributing to this:

During August and early September, we recycled 36% of construction waste products. As a company, we would normally recycle a far greater proportion of excavated materials. This figure reflects the quantity of clay which has been exposed at this site. Clay is unfortunately a waste product which cannot be recycled.

In terms of noise pollution, we have worked closely with the Environment team from Gravesham Borough Council to lessen disruption in the locality by keeping working times to a minimum and limiting weekend works.

**We've been working hard to deliver this project on time... throughout August our teams have worked a total of 1274 hours!**
