Kent County Council in exercise of its powers conferred by section 33A (2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order -

- 1. This Order may be cited as 'The Kent County Council Permit Scheme Order 2015' and shall come into force on 1st October 2015.
- 2. The Kent Country Council Permit Scheme which came into effect on 25th January 2010 under the 'Traffic Management (Kent County Council) Permit Scheme Order 2009' is varied to comply with the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.
- 3. The area covered by the Kent Permit Scheme is the County of Kent excluding the Medway Council area. All streets for which Kent County Council is the highway authority, i.e. publicly maintained by or on behalf of Kent County Council, are included in the Kent County Council Permit Scheme.
- 4. The Kent County Council Permit Scheme set out in the Schedule to this Order comes into effect on 1st October 2015.
- 5. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 shall apply to the specified streets within the Kent County Council Permit Scheme.
