#### **NOTE 1**

For this financial year, some dry-recycling tonnage from the 13 Kent councils was processed through Materials Recycling Facilities (MRFs) or with companies who may send their feedstocks abroad (e.g. wood for biomass). The KRP thanks Countrystyle Recycling Ltd and Viridor Waste Kent Ltd for the provision of information to us about the countries of end destination of their outputs. The KRP is very grateful for the co-operation shown.

#### **NOTE 2**

On the basis of industry experience for tonnages via charities, we have allocated tonnages 'abroad'. This includes items (e.g. clothes) that are collected by UK based charities and re-used by people in other countries.

#### **NOTE 3**

Waste Data Flow publishes information for 'Kent County Council' even though this is an amalgamation of all 13 Kent councils' information. Thus, the information for Kent Resource Partnership on pages 7 to 13 also incorporates all tonnages for Kent County Council.

#### **Note 4**

Every effort has been made to ensure the figures in this publication are correct. However, as the figures are based heavily on information from the national Waste Data Flow system, factors that impact on calculations are very likely to be replicated in this publication. # Foreword

On behalf of the Kent Resource Partnership (KRP), we are pleased to share findings from our latest Materials End Destinations Publication for 2015/16. This is our fifth publication with the overall objective, as with previous years, to provide open information on where Kent's materials end up. To mark the fifth publication, additional pages (pp 38 to 50) have been included to reflect the '5 year picture' from 2011/12 to 2015/16.

The total household materials collected by the 13 Kent councils was just over 716,000 tonnes. In the last four years, Kent's total household waste has grown year on year; a trend reflecting the national tonnages collected by local authorities across the country. Meeting the challenges of waste minimisation and resource efficiency is what drives our determination and commitment to collaborative working across Kent and beyond. In March 2016 the KRP were early signatories to the ambitious agreement led by the Waste & Resources Action Programme (WRAP), to bring together organisations across the food system - from producer to consumer - to make food and drink production and consumption more sustainable. The KRP looks forward to working with WRAP, and others, to achieve this project's goals.

We are delighted to report that over 92% of Kent's materials were reprocessed within the UK, with just under 8% sent abroad for treatment. Of this 92%, more than 4 tonnes out of every 5 was handled within the County, keeping transport and environmental costs low. This high level of performance has been sustained for the last five years. The work done by all our partners to minimise 'waste miles' is a story we are proud to share with our residents, and others across the resource industry.

Over the last 5 years our recycling rate has continued to make progress, from 41% in 2011/12 to just over 44% in 2015/16, with a degree of variation year on year. As one of the 'Big Ticket Items' for the KRP, we will continue our efforts to improve recycle quantity and quality with the overarching aim to achieve our 50% recycling/composting target by 2020/21.

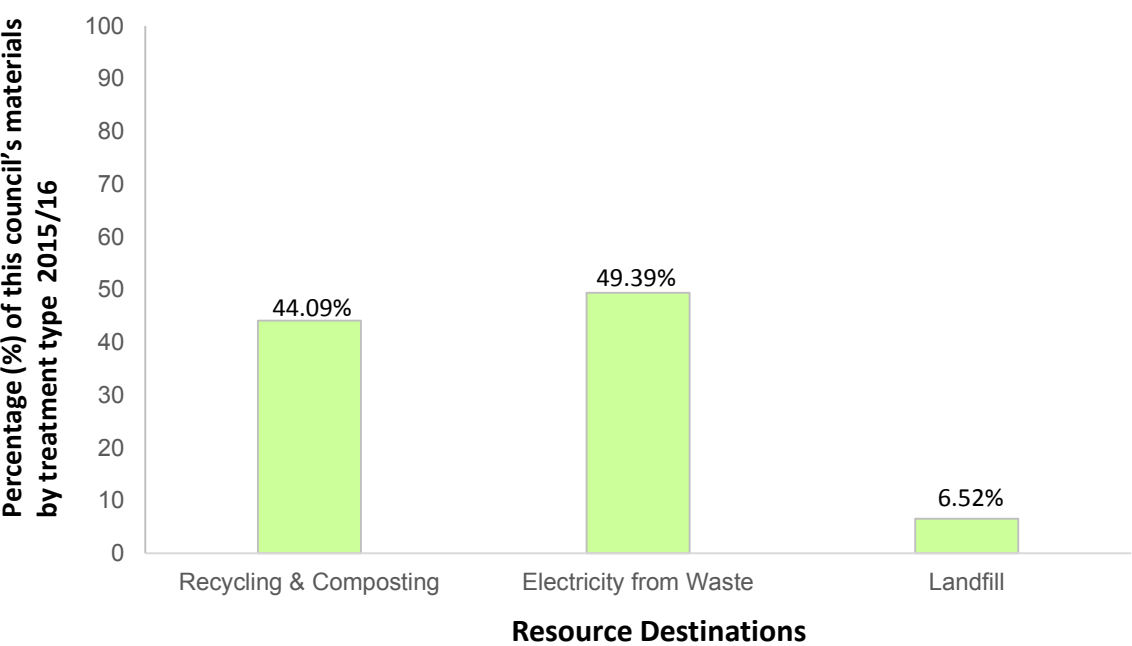
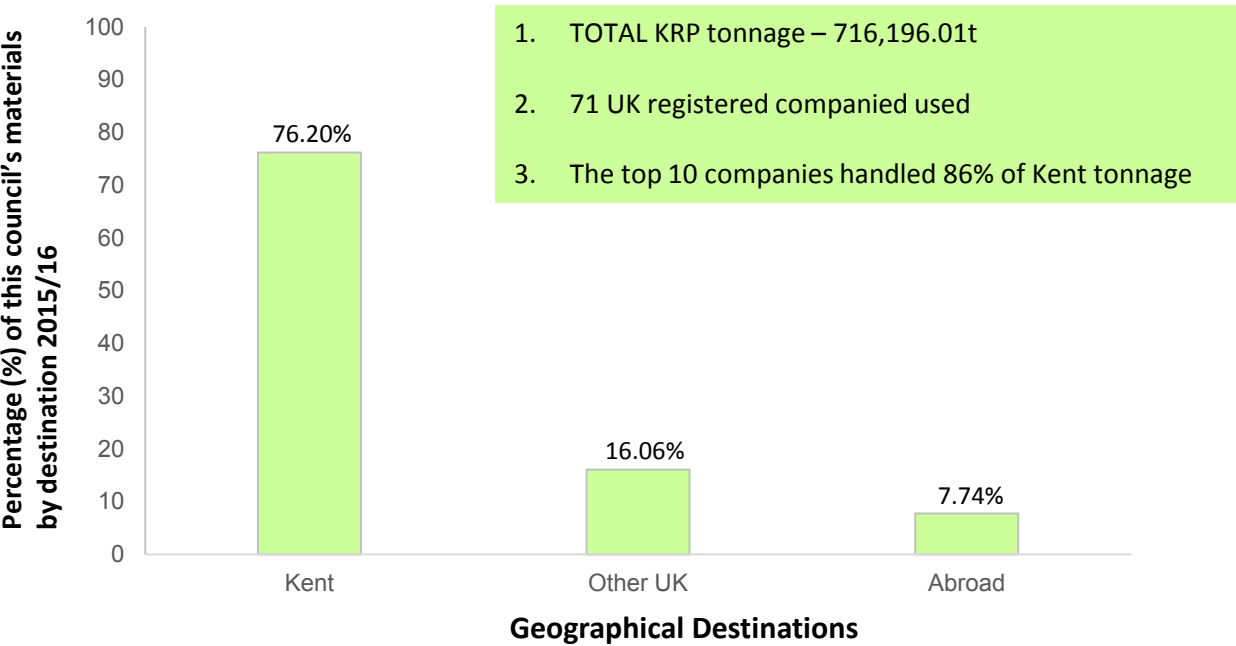
We are pleased to announce that the KRP's landfill figure for 2015/16 was just under 7%, surpassing our own 10% landfill target set for the year. This is remarkable progress given that in 2011/12 the landfill figure was over 22%. The KRP will continue to strive towards zero household materials sent to landfill and are on course to achieving our medium term goal of no more than 5% sent to landfill by 2020/21.

We would like to extend our thanks to the KRP Manager, Paldeep Bhatti, and our Projects Officer, Kate McCall as well as Kent County Council colleagues, Cathy Smythe and Nichola Hood for their valuable work to produce this publication. Special thanks goes to the Resource Association and the continued co-operation from waste management companies, Countrystyle and Viridor.

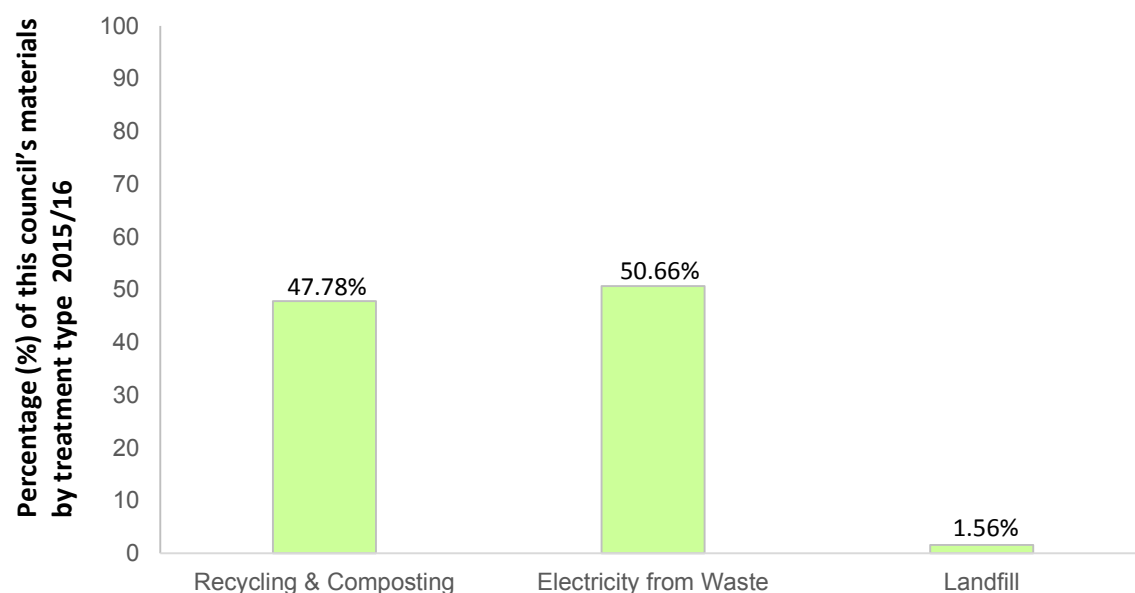
