

KYV Meeting Summary – October 2022

At the October KYV meeting 27 members were present.

Campaign updates

Mental health – The group reflected on the completed Mental Health Friends Handbook as well as the Big Mental Health Conversation. The group considered ideas on how to ensure young people receive the handbook such as handing it out in form time or assembly.

Building Resilience – The group planned a promotional video for the Building Resilience board game.

Feeling safe – Looking over an anti-bullying poster, the group discussed changes wanted by the young people.

Environment – For their sourcing trip, the group agreed it would be better to lock in a date for Spring 2023. The group are aware they need to have the Education Pack Materials completed by the end of the year.

KYCC Welcome Session-

The group considered the Right to Recall, an amendment put forward to make it easier to recall those in leadership roles, which was passed by KYCC members. It will now go out for consultation with other changes to the KYCC Constitution during November and December.

Project time -

Opportunities for Young People – Going over poster designs, the group agreed on one which, with slight tweaks, will be ready to go to print and then be sent out to schools.

Disability Awareness – Looking over their July session takeover and the year in general, the group concluded the videos were well chosen and both the Kahoot and picture game were well organised. However, if they were to do it again, they would focus on their presentation skills.

UKYP – Jamie reminded MYP's to check all emails from BYC regarding the day and also reminded them that Hannah and Amy will be the staff attending the 4th November House of Commons visit. MYP also reminded to give schools consent forms given to them from the BYC.

Also discussed were the findings from this year's Make your Mark report. Young People discussed the work they did on supporting this. This report highlighted the 5 main areas young people voted on in the Southeast. Group have decided to vote on which topic to concentrate on at the November meeting.
