BE REALISTIC

You are buying a used car - don't expect perfection! Think about what journeys you will make. Know what you can afford and stick to it. Don't forget costs like insurance, servicing, parts and fuel.

DO YOUR RESEARCH

Once you know the type of car you are looking for, do some research. Shop around, look for customer reviews of your dealership online, ask friends and family. **3** ASK QUESTIONS

Ask the dealer about...

- The condition of the car
- Repairs carried out on the car
- What happens if things go wrong
- MOT certificates
- Service history
- V5C registration document (logbook)

BE SURE

- Check the car for rust, electrics, dents etc.
- Take someone with you
- Ask for copies of paperwork
- Take it for a test drive
- Consider paying for an inspection

I'VE HAD A PROBLEM WITH MY SECOND HAND CAR, WHAT SHOULD I DO?



- Tell the dealer as soon as you can
- Allow the dealer to look at the car
- Ask the dealer to contact you when they have found a fault
- Tell the dealer if you are unhappy with their service

#### YOU SHOULD NOT...

- Ignore the problem
- Expect a courtesy car
- Take the car to another business before the dealer has looked at the car
- Stop paying finance
