The Kent County Council Act 2001 requires holders of Occasional Sales (such as boot fairs, antique fairs, computer fairs) to keep records of all sellers who attend. It is for this reason you are required to provide the information below.

It is a criminal offence to supply false information. Those who intentionally provide false details could be prosecuted and are liable on conviction to a maximum fine of £2500.
