

Employee jobs in Kent in 2023

Business Register & Employment Survey data for 2023 was released by the Office for National Statistics on 4 November 2024.

NOTE: Within this bulletin 'Kent' refers to the Kent County Council area (KCC) which excludes Medway.

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Kent Facts & Figures

This bulletin presents the latest provisional data from the Business Register & Employment Survey. It looks at the structure of jobs in Kent districts in 2023 with national and regional comparisons.

Kent Summary

- Employee jobs in Kent have increased by 0.8% over the previous year (+5,400 employee jobs).
 This is lower than the national and regional increase (GB +1.4%, South East +1.3%).
- In Kent the biggest number increase was in Human health and social work activities jobs (+12,500 jobs, +15.0%).
- There were fewer jobs in seven sectors in Kent.
 The biggest number reduction since the previous year was in Administrative and support service industries (-6,500 jobs, -10.5%).
- Kent has a larger proportion of jobs in 8 industrial sectors compared to Great Britain. The biggest difference was in Wholesale & retail trade industries. In Kent they make up 16.2% of all jobs compared to GB 13.6%.





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Introduction

The Business Register and Employment Survey (BRES) is regarded as the definitive source of official employee and employment statistics by industry.

The BRES is a sample survey from the Office for National Statistics (ONS) which collects employment information from businesses across the whole of the Great Britain economy for each site that they operate. The survey covers all businesses in Great Britain registered for VAT and/or PAYE. It does not cover the very small businesses which are neither registered for VAT nor PAYE, neither does it include self-employed workers unless they are registered for VAT or PAYE.

The data provides us with an estimate of employee jobs and total employment. An employee is defined as anyone aged 16 years or over who is paid directly from the payroll, in return for carrying out a full-time or part-time job or being on a training scheme. Employment includes employees plus the number of working owners who receive drawings or a share of the profits.

Employee jobs (used in this bulletin) is the more robust of the two measures and is recommended for use in analysis.

As the BRES is a sample survey it produces estimated employment figures. These estimates are of a good quality at higher levels of geography (for example region) however the quality of the estimates deteriorates as the geographies get smaller. This should be remembered when considering the quality of county and district estimates.

For the 2023 survey period, approximately 85,000 businesses were sampled for Great Britain with an 83.3% response rate.

The industrial sectors used in this bulletin are defined using the 2007 Standard Industrial Classification (2007SIC). Detailed information about the types of industry which make up each of the industrial sectors is available from the UK Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities published by the Office for National Statistics.

To comply with the ONS requirements, all data is rounded to the nearest 100, however percentages are calculated using unrounded data.

The latest data is for 2023 and is provisional. This includes revisions to 2022 data.





The BRES is a sample survey of approximately 85,000 businesses. As such it may be subject to sampling errors. Information on the quality and methodology of the BRES is available from the Office For National Statistics website.

Changes to the BRES

In 2015 The Office for National Statistics (ONS) decided to include businesses registered for PAYE for which no VAT data are available. Prior to 2015, such businesses were excluded and therefore not included in the ONS estimates.

This has resulted in an improvement in coverage and is estimated to have increased the business survey population by around 100,000 businesses, with a total of around 200,000 employees. The increase in business population has led to an increase in the estimate of employment and employees for the 2015 dataset.

This increase in coverage makes comparisons of figures prior to 2015 with figures from 2015 onwards more difficult since the employment estimates prior to 2015 do not include PAYE-only businesses.

Data using the revised methodology is available for the years 2015 to 2023. The change in methodology means that this data is not comparable with earlier years.

Data for earlier years using the old methodology is presented in the <u>BRES 2009-2015</u> bulletin.

BRES Analysis

Table 1 overleaf summarises the latest data for Kent, together with regional and national comparisons.

Estimates show that employee jobs increased by 0.8% in Kent between 2022 and 2023. Nationally (GB) they increased by 1.4% and regionally by 1.3%. The figures indicate no change in employee jobs in the Medway area.

Chart 1: Percentage change in employee jobs




Chart 2 shows the change in employees between 2022 and 2023 by sector in Great Britain.

Looking at the industrial breakdown of employee jobs we can see those industries which have seen growth over the last year and those that have seen a reduction in employees.






Overall employee jobs have increased nationally by 1.4% (424,500 more employee jobs).

Since 2022 four sectors nationally saw a reduction in employee jobs. Administrative and support service activities industries saw the biggest number and percentage reduction in jobs with 63,500 fewer jobs than in 2022, a reduction of 4.4%. The other industries which saw a reduction in employee jobs were Wholesale and Retail Trade which saw 25,500 fewer jobs in 2023 (0.6% fewer than in 2022), Construction which saw 9,500 fewer jobs (down 0.6%), and Primary industries, which includes agriculture, mining, and utilities, which had 5,000 fewer jobs (a reduction of 0.8%).

Human health and social work activities saw the biggest number increase with 181,500 more employee jobs than the year before, an increase of 4.4%, while Arts, entertainment and recreation saw the biggest percentage increase (+8.0% or 59,500 more jobs).

Chart 2: Great Britain industrial structure change






Chart 3 overleaf shows the change in employees since 2022 by sector in Kent.

The data shows Kent to have seen reductions in employee jobs in eight of the sixteen industrial sectors.






The Administration and support services activities sector has seen the biggest reduction in number of jobs (-6,500 jobs equivalent to a 10.5% reduction in jobs). The biggest percentage decrease was in Primary industries which saw a 12.5% reduction equivalent to 2,600 fewer jobs.

The Human health and social work activities sector saw the biggest number growth in jobs (+12,500 jobs equivalent to a 15.0% increase), while Accommodation and food service activities saw the biggest percentage growth (+7,500 jobs, +15.3%).

Chart 3: Kent industrial structure change






The industrial structure for both Kent and Great Britain as of 2023 is shown in chart 4.

Relative to Great Britain, Kent has a higher proportion of employees in eight industrial sectors:

- Human health and social work activities
- Education
- Accommodation and food service activities
- Transportation and storage
- Wholesale and retail trade
- Construction
- Primary Industries (Agriculture/Mining/Utilities)
- Other service activities

The sectors where Kent has lower proportions of employees compared to Great Britain are:

- Manufacturing
- Information and communication
- Financial and insurance activities
- Professional, scientific, and technical activities
- Public administration and defence
- Administrative and support service activities
- Real estate activities





Kent has an equal proportion of employee jobs in the Arts, entertainment and recreation industry as Great Britain.

The following tables show the employee numbers for each of the Kent Districts and Medway, plus regional and national comparator areas.

A number of individual entries have been highlighted as containing possible sampling errors. These have been identified as looking out of place compared to previous years' data. BRES adheres to a revisions policy whereby current survey estimates together with a revision of the previous year's survey estimates are published. Late returns or information received over the following year's survey may lead to changes to the estimates after the provisional publication. These changes are incorporated into the figures when the revised estimates are published in the following year.

As a result of this sampling variability, we advise caution in the interpretation and use of the highlighted numbers.
