

Business Register & Employment Survey (BRES) 2020

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NOTE: within this bulletin 'Kent' refers to the Kent County Council (KCC) area which excludes Medway

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Introduction

This bulletin presents the latest provisional data from the Business Register & Employment Survey. It looks at the structure of employee jobs in Kent districts in 2020 with national and regional comparisons.

Kent summary

- Coronavirus has had an effect on the production of jobs estimates resulting in lower levels of precision in 2020 figures than in previous years.
- Employee jobs in Kent have fallen by 2.2% (-14,000 jobs) over the last year. This is lower than the regional (-2.5%) but above the national average (-1.9%).
- The biggest number and percentage increase in jobs was in construction (+5,000 jobs, +11.9%).
- There were fewer jobs in eight industrial sectors in Kent. The biggest reduction was in the wholesale and retail trade sector (-9,000 jobs, -8.1%).
- Kent has a larger proportion of jobs in eight sectors than seen nationally. The biggest differences are in construction (Kent 7.7%, GB 4.8%) and wholesale and retail trade (Kent 16.6%, GB 14.8%).

The Business Register and Employment Survey (BRES) is regarded as the definitive source of official employee and employment statistics by industry.

The Business Register and Employment Survey (BRES) is a sample survey from the Office for National Statistics (ONS) which collects employment information from businesses across the whole of the Great Britain economy for each site that they operate. The survey covers all businesses in Great Britain registered for VAT and/or PAYE. BRES does not cover the very small businesses neither registered for VAT nor PAYE, neither does it include self-employed workers unless they are registered for VAT or PAYE.

The data provides us with an estimate of employee jobs and total employment. An employee is defined as anyone aged 16 years or over who is paid directly from the payroll, in return for carrying out a full-time or part-time job or being on a training scheme. Employment includes employees plus the number of working owners who receive drawings or a share of the profits.

Employee jobs (used in this bulletin) is the more robust of the two measures and is recommended for use in analysis.

As the BRES is a sample survey it produces **estimated** employment figures. These estimates are of a good quality at higher levels of geography (for example region) however the quality of the estimates deteriorates as the geographies get smaller. This should be taken into account when considering the quality of county and district estimates.

For the 2020 survey period, approximately 85,000 businesses were sampled for Great Britain with a 72.6% response rate.

The industrial sectors used in this bulletin are defined using the 2007 Standard Industrial Classification (2007SIC). Detailed information about the types of industry which make up each of the industrial sectors is available from the [UK Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities](#) published by the Office for National Statistics.

To comply with ONS requirements, all data is rounded to the nearest 100, however percentages are calculated using unrounded data.

The latest data is for 2020. This includes revisions to 2019 data.

The BRES is a sample survey of approximately 85,000 businesses. As such it may be subject to sampling errors. More information on the quality and methodology of the BRES can be found [here](#).

Changes to the BRES

In 2015 The Office for National Statistics (ONS) decided to include businesses registered for PAYE for which no VAT data are available. Prior to 2015, such businesses were excluded and therefore not included in the ONS estimates.

This has resulted in an improvement in coverage and is estimated to have increased the business survey population by around 100,000 businesses, with a total of around 200,000 employees. The increase in business population has led to an increase in the estimate of employment and employees for the 2015 dataset.

This increase in coverage makes comparisons of figures prior to 2015 with figures from 2015 onwards more difficult since the employment estimates prior to 2015 do not include PAYE-only businesses.

Data using the revised methodology is available for the years 2015 to 2020. The change in methodology means that this data is not comparable with earlier years.

Impact of Coronavirus

The Business Register and Employment Survey (BRES) reference date of 11 September 2020 meant that coronavirus (COVID-19) had a tangible effect on producing estimates. This indicates lower levels of precision than in previous years. The response rate for the 2020 BRES was 72.6%, which was lower than the 2019 BRES response rate of 83.6%.

BRES Analysis

Table 1 summarises the latest data for Kent, together with regional and national comparisons.

Estimates show that employee jobs fell by 2.2% in Kent between 2019 and 2020. Nationally they fell by 1.9% and regionally by 2.5%. The figures indicate an increase of 0.9% in the Medway area.

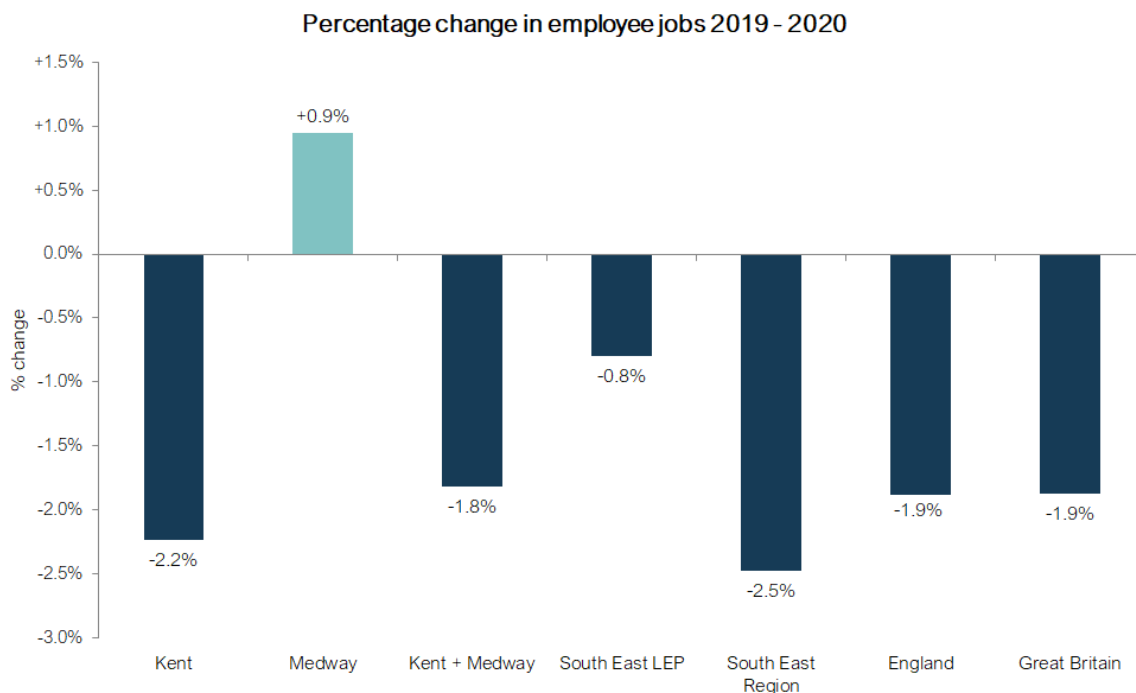

Chart 1 shows the percentage change in employee jobs in Kent and Medway compared to national and regional changes.

Looking at the industrial sector data we can see those industries which have seen growth over the last year and those that have seen a reduction in employees.

Chart 2 shows the change in employees between 2019 and 2020 by sector in Great Britain.

Overall employee jobs have fallen nationally by 1.9% (562,000 fewer employee jobs).

Since 2019 nine sectors nationally saw a reduction in employee jobs. Accommodation and food services saw the biggest number reduction in jobs with 179,00 fewer jobs than in

2019, a reduction of 7.8%. Arts, entertainment, and recreation industries saw the biggest percentage reduction of -11.2% (-83,000 jobs).

Human health and social work activities saw the biggest increase with 72,000 more employee jobs than the year before, an increase of 1.8%. The biggest percentage increase was in primary industries (agriculture/mining/utilities) which saw an increase of 3.7% (+22,000 employee jobs).

% Change 2019-2020, Great Britain

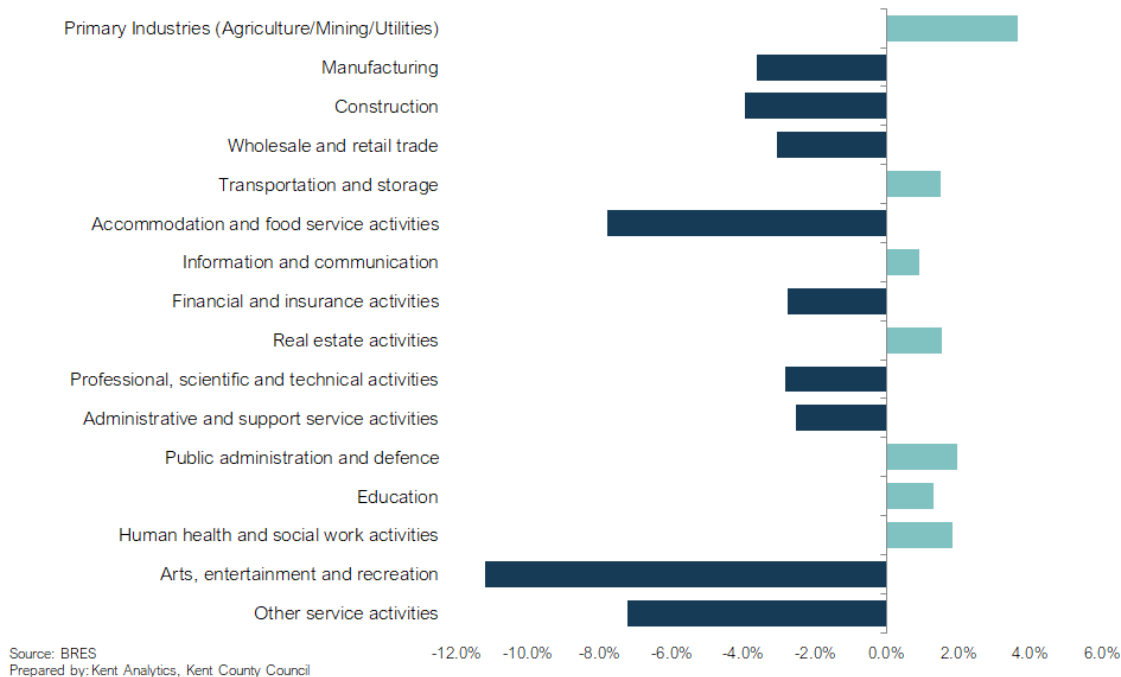


Chart 3 overleaf shows the change in employees since 2019 by sector in Kent.

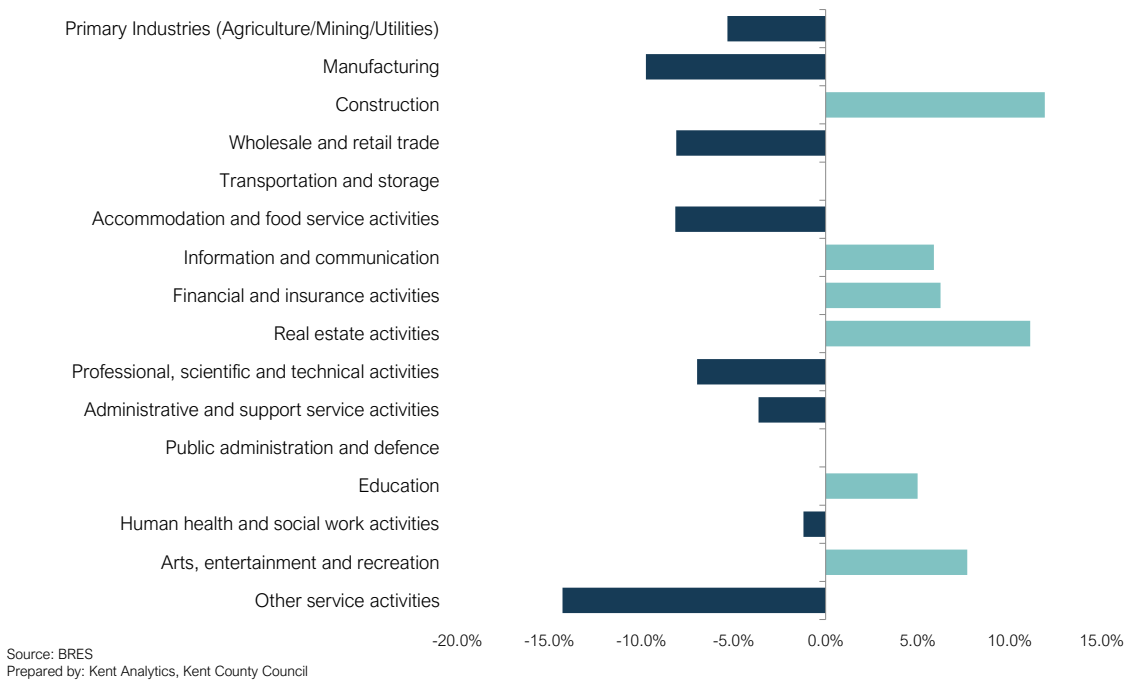
The data shows Kent to have seen reductions in employee jobs in eight of the sixteen industrial sectors.

The wholesale and retail trade sector has seen the biggest reduction in number of jobs (-9,000 jobs equivalent to an 8.1% reduction in jobs). The biggest percentage decrease was in other service activities (which includes personal services such as repair of household goods and other personal services) which saw a 14.3% reduction equivalent to 2,000 fewer jobs.

The construction services sector saw the biggest number and percentage growth in jobs (+5,000 jobs, +11.9%). The real estate activities sector saw a similar percentage increase (+11.1%, +1,000 jobs).

Chart 3: Kent industrial structure change

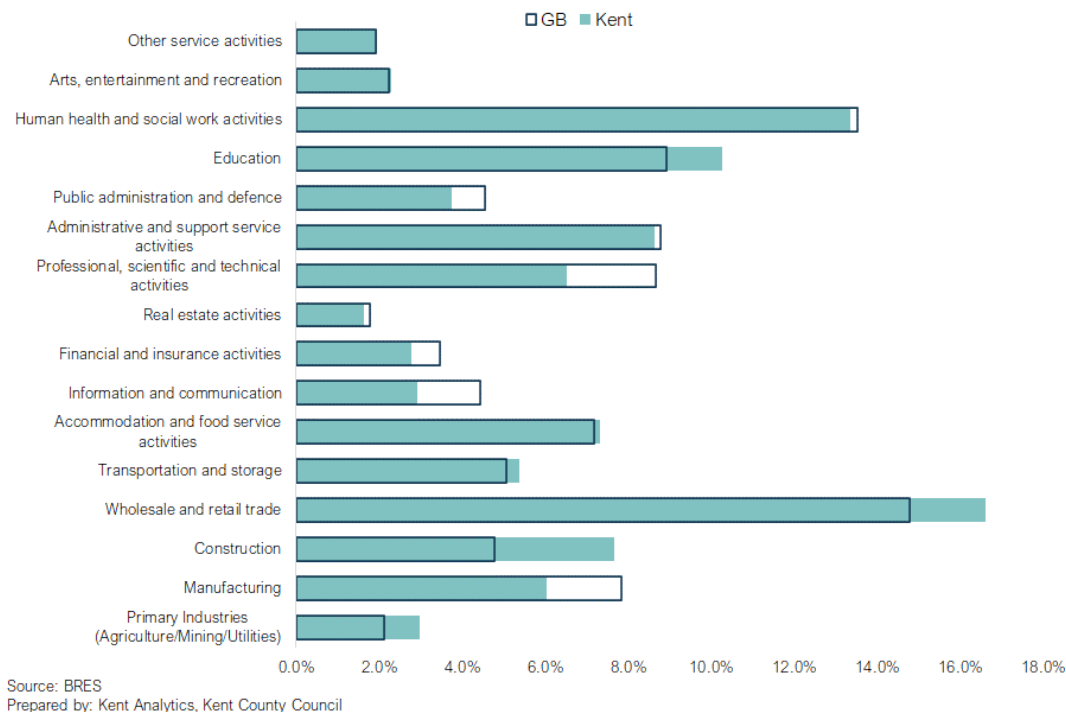

Relative to Great Britain as a whole, Kent has a higher proportion of employees in eight industrial sectors:

- Other service activities
- Arts, entertainment, and recreation
- Education
- Accommodation and food services
- Transportation and storage
- Wholesale and retail trade
- Construction
- Primary Industries (Agriculture/Mining/Utilities)

The sectors where Kent has significantly lower proportions of employees compared to Great Britain are:

- Manufacturing
- Information and communication
- Financial and insurance activities
- Professional, scientific, and technical activities
- Public administration and defence

The following tables show the employee numbers for each of the Kent Districts and Medway, plus regional and national comparator areas.

A number of individual entries have been highlighted as containing possible sampling errors. These have been identified as looking out of place compared to previous years' data. BRES adheres to a revisions policy whereby current survey estimates together with a revision of the previous year's survey estimates are published. Late returns or information received over the following year's survey may lead to changes to the estimates after the provisional publication. These changes are incorporated into the figures when the revised estimates are published in the following year.

As a result of this sampling variability, we advise caution in the interpretation and use of the highlighted numbers.
