Kent facts and figures

The 2023 Mid-year population estimates are the third set of estimates based on the recent 2021 Census.

Summary of findings.

- The 2023 mid-year population estimates show that Kent is the most populous county council area in the South East with a population of 1,610,300 people.
- Maidstone has the largest population of the local authorities in Kent with 184,200 people, which is 11.4% of Kent's total population. Gravesham has the smallest population in Kent with 107,700 people, which is 6.7% of Kent's total population.
- There are more female than male residents in Kent, 51.3% (826,200) female and 48.7% (784,100) male.
 This pattern is seen in England and in all of Kent's local authority districts.
- The mean age of the population in Kent is 41.7 years, a year older than the national mean age of 40.7 years.
- The mean age of a Kent female is 42.6 and a Kent male is 40.7.

Introduction

This bulletin presents the mid-2023 population estimates (MYPE) by age and sex.

Only population estimates for 2023 are presented here but further details including a time series of estimates are available on our <u>population and census webpages</u> in the bulletins and excel toolkits listed below:

- '2023 Mid-year population estimates: Total population in Kent' presents total population between 2022 and 2023.
- 'Time series of Mid-year population estimates 2003-2023' presents total population between 2003 and 2023.
- What is causing Kent's population growth?' examines the reasons behind the changes in population.
- 'Interactive population estimates toolkit' allows access to population estimates for any chosen age group for all 12 Kent local authority districts and Kent County as a whole, between 2003 and 2023.

It is ONS policy to present all estimates rounded to the nearest hundred. Within this bulletin all numbers have been individually rounded and therefore may not sum. Percentages have been calculated using unrounded numbers.





Total population by sex of Kent local authorities

The 2023 mid-year population estimate for Kent is 1,610,300 people. Of the local authorities in Kent, Maidstone has the largest population with 184,200 people, which is equivalent to 11.4% of Kent's total population. Gravesham has the smallest population in Kent with 107,700 people, which is equivalent to 6.7% of Kent's total population.

There are more females than males in Kent with 51.3% females to 48.7% male. This pattern is seen in England and in all of Kent's local authority districts. Sevenoaks has the greatest proportion of females to males (51.9% female compared to 48.1% male). The difference is smallest in Swale (50.5% female compared to 49.5% male). Table 1 presents the total population, by gender.

Mean age of Kent local authorities.

The mean age of residents in Kent is 41.7 years. This is one year older than the national average of 40.7 years. The mean age of a Kent female is 42.6 years compared to the

national average of 41.5 years. The mean age of a Kent male is 40.7 compared to the national average of 39.8 years.

Mean age is higher in the East Kent coastal area with the mean age of residents in Dover, Folkestone & Hythe, and Thanet all above 43 years. Canterbury, Sevenoaks and Tunbridge Wells also have a higher mean age than the Kent average. Mean age is youngest in Dartford (North Kent) at 37.4 years.

Folkestone & Hythe has the oldest mean age for females at 45.9 years and the oldest mean age for males at 44.0 years. Dartford has the youngest mean age for both females at 38.0 years and males at 36.6 years. Table 2 outlines mean age by sex for all Kent local authority districts.

The male/female ratio changes with age. Generally, there are more males compared to females in the younger age groups, but as age increases there become more females to males. This is presented graphically in the population pyramids and tables for Kent, each of the Kent local authority districts, Medway Unitary Authority and England on pages 4 to 18.

Chart 1: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex - Kent

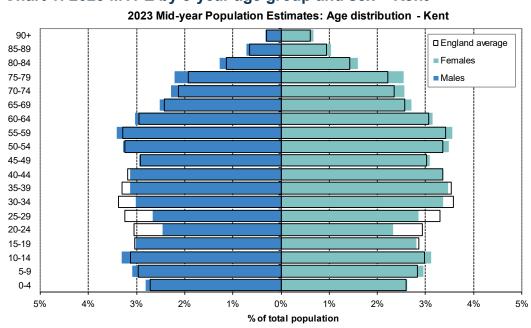

Chart 2: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex – Ashford

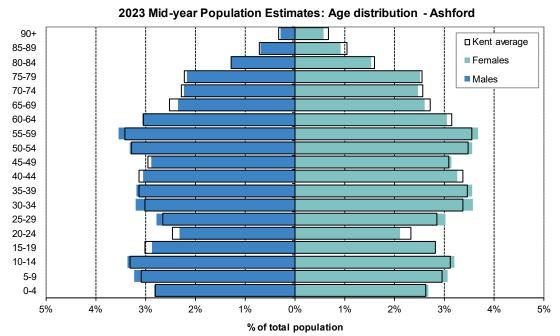

Chart 3: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex – Canterbury

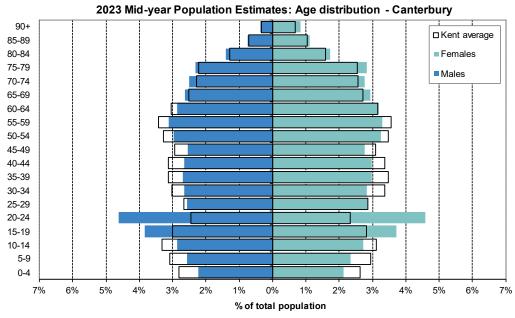

Chart 4: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex - Dartford

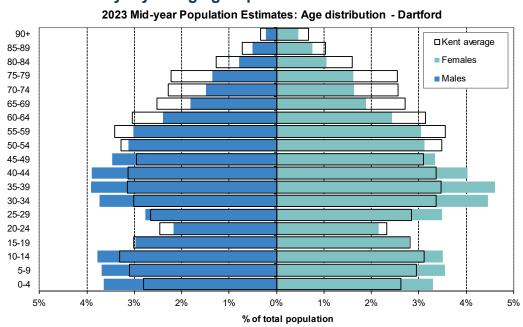

Chart 5: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex – Dover

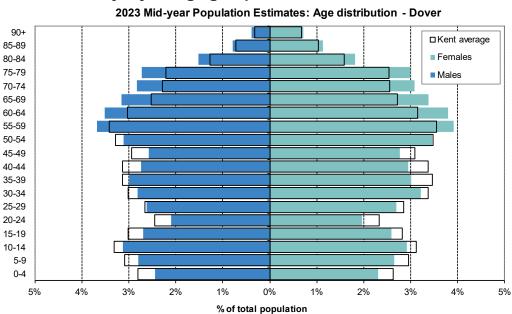






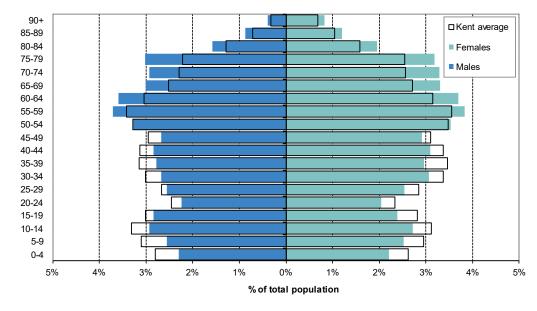

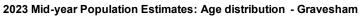

Chart 7: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex - Gravesham



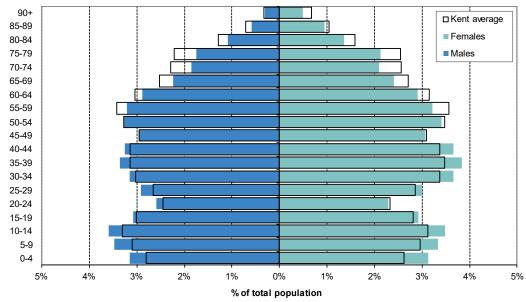

Chart 8: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex – Maidstone

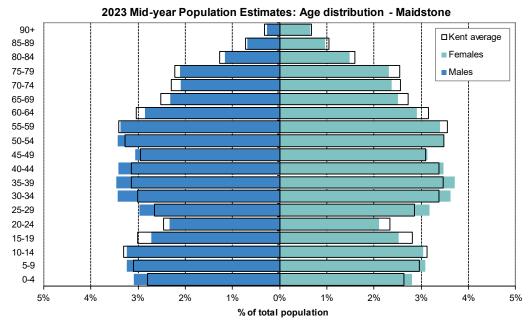

Chart 9: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex - Sevenoaks

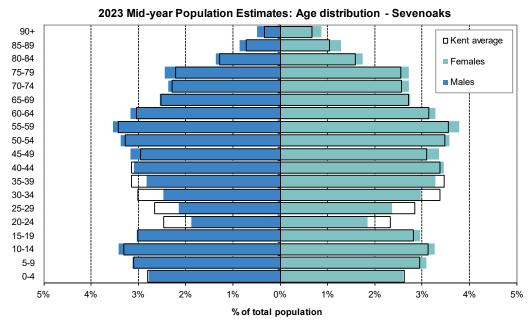

Chart 10: 2023 MYPE by 5-year age group and sex – Swale

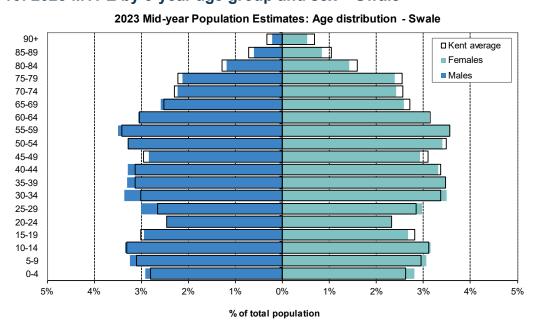




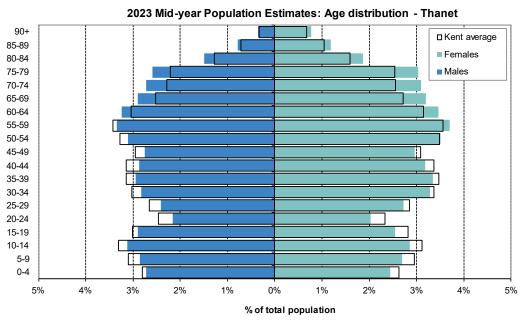

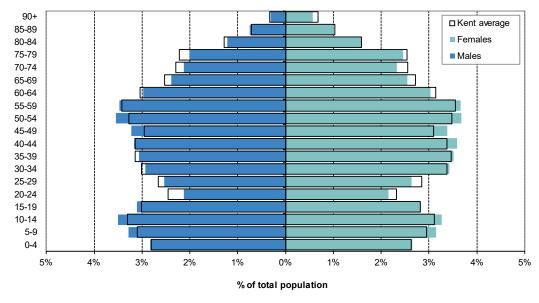

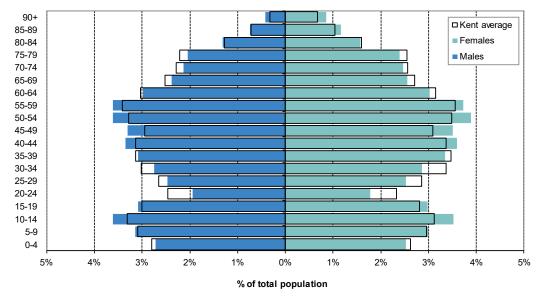

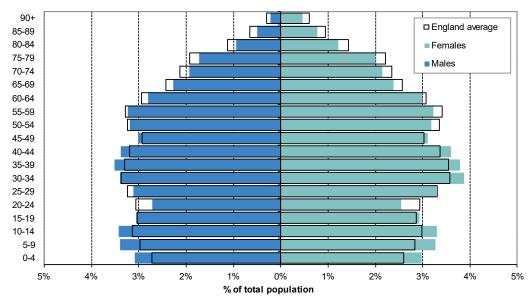




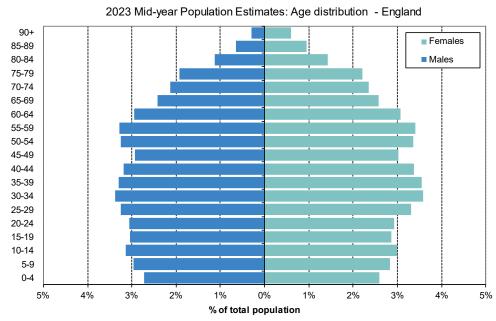
