## **Multi-agency safeguarding adults training:**

### **Collaborative working in multi-agency Section 42 Enquiries** **Half-day workshop**

The training has been agreed and is commissioned by the Kent and Medway Safeguarding Adults Board, and is developed as part of an integrated programme of development for staff from statutory partner agencies. Each agency provides its own introductory safeguarding adults training, as well as other associated learning. Contact your agency's lead for learning and development to discuss available training relevant for your role.

This course is primarily for those staff with responsibility for direct practice in safeguarding. As safeguarding is integral to all work, it is important that delegates who attend the course have the agreement and support of their line manager and that adequate cover for attendee's absence has been arranged.

#### **Coronavirus COVID-19 update**

Whilst face to face training is not possible, facilitated online training sessions have been designed, enabling delegates to participate through a video conferencing platform, which will ensure training is interactive, practical and relevant to practice.

The Domestic Abuse workshop will be delivered across two half-day remote training sessions of 3 hours each, with built-in breaks. Where these take place on different dates, delegates must be able to attend both dates with the same group.

Course workbooks will be e-mailed in advance, along with detailed instructions for participants, including any preparation which may be required.

## Who this course is for

Those with some experience and knowledge of safeguarding and who have completed their agency basic training. Delegates wishing to book a place should ensure the training is appropriate for their role and ideally the training need will have been identified in discussions with their manager.

## Learning objectives

1. Knowledge of the statutory basis for conducting a Safeguarding Enquiry
2. Understanding of the different stages of a Section 42 Enquiry
3. Understanding of the importance of the terms of reference for any Enquiry
4. To fully explore the integration of Making Safeguarding Personal (MSP) in an Enquiry
5. Use of risk assessment/analysis in any Enquiry, in decision-making and in drawing conclusion
6. Information sharing between agencies

The course will use case examples to explore ideas. The family focus to an Enquiry will be discussed and the Multi-agency Policy, Protocols and Practitioner Guidance document will be used. The use of risk assessments and analysis tools will be explored, as will methods of case review to enable better outcomes for the Enquiry.
