

Sexual Harassment Survey

This survey has been designed and distributed by the Kent Youth County Council interest group of eliminating sexual harassment, with the aim of investigating the predominance of sexual harassment among young people.

Sexual harassment is when someone behaves in a way that makes you feel distressed, intimidated or offended and the behaviour is of a sexual nature. This includes:

- Sexual comments or jokes
- Physical behaviour; unwelcome sexual advances, touching and various forms of sexual assault
- Displaying photos, pictures or drawings of a sexual nature
- Sending messages, emails etc. with sexual content
